ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

The following are the primary day-to-day responsibilities for this position. These are not exclusive or all-inclusive. Other duties may be required and assigned.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Assists with both pre-production, live production, and post-production tasks for photography and video assignments.
- Assists with set-up, and breakdown of AV gear used for live events and recordings.
- Upload, tag, and organize photo and video files to offline and online storage media/platform.
- Keeps track of AV requests and event calendar.
- Ability to travel locally and out of state to record Zaytuna events and student activity.
- Transcribe short-form video for use as subtitle tracks on social media.

- Fulfills other audio/visual-related duties as determined by the Audiovisual Manager.
