

## **Gender Relations**

Zaytuna College encourages gender interactions that are purposeful and that foster wholesome relationships. Dating, sexual activity, and romantic relationships among unmarried students are not allowed on campus. These Islamic norms are observed at Zaytuna as an aid to spiritual growth and focused learning environment.

## **Dress**

The dress and grooming of both men and women should be modest, neat, and clean. Course participants are asked not to wear shorts, leggings, yoga pants, or shirts/tops that do not cover the shoulders while on the campus.

## **Prohibition of Smoking, Alcohol, Marijuana, and Illegal Drugs**

Possession or use of alcohol, marijuana, illegal drugs, is strictly prohibited on or in the vicinity of the campus. Smoking, vaping, or the use of tobacco products are not allowed on the campus, including entranceways.

## **Policy on Violence**

Zaytuna College requires employees and students to treat others fairly and with dignity. Differences between persons are to be resolved with civility and without reprisals. All members of the community should feel safe, secure, and free from harassment. No form of racism, sexism, prejudice or violence will be tolerated, including physical abuse, verbal abuse, threats of violence, vandalism, destruction of property, or any behavior that endangers the safety or well-being of any person. The use or possession of weapons, as defined under California law, is prohibited.

## **Trespassing**

Participants are prohibited from entering any private room or normally locked room or common area without following security procedures or obtaining appropriate permission. Students may be subject to disciplinary action for entering or accessing restricted areas (e.g., private rooms or offices, emergency exit doors, fire escape doors, attic/roof access doors, or the bell tower) without authorization, and/or for their unauthorized presence in or on rooftops, ledges, seismic bracing, fire escapes, attic space, emergency exits, or any area marked as or known to be restricted in any residential or campus facility. Climbing on any College building or property rented by Zaytuna College is prohibited. Using windows for entrance or exit during nonemergency situations or tampering with or removing windows, window screens, window stops, or security screens is prohibited. Violation of these rules will result in an automatic fine of \$100, and further disciplinary action may be taken against students in violation of these rules. Unauthorized staff members should not be approached with requests for access to the any restricted areas. Allegations of violations should be reported to the Administrative Assistant to the Director of Student Life.
